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Did you know?

In Windows 7 the *Show Desktop* taskbar icon has changed—now it's a rather inconspicuous grey rectangle in the extreme bottom right of your screen

If you purchase the Q-SYS Graphics module, you can instantly create any graph from your Q-SYS data without further manipulation in Excel and you can print, pdf and email directly

You can use the built-in Q-SYS Event Scheduler to automatically perform tasks each day. This could include running reports, emailing warnings or carrying out system checks such as if last night's backup was successful.

You can now set up Q-SYS to automatically send faxes to your customers or suppliers. This works in a similar way to emailing, and a complete audit record is kept of all faxes sent.

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MEDIA CONTROL IN LIMS

By popular request, we are continuing to enhance this module which is included free of charge if you have an up to date version of Q-SYS installed. Recent improvements have included additional customisable fields for recording batch-related information, an auditable batch note, and new management reports.

Managing media and reagents is an important laboratory function that you can completely automate using Q-SYS... why not think about implementing it this year?

TECHNICAL TIP—WINDOWS SERVER 2008

On Windows Server 2008,  Windows Server 2008 having set *Regional and Language* formats to UK, you may also need to copy these settings to "reserved accounts", such as the system account.

Otherwise system logs, including the Q-SYS Backup Log, will have dates appearing in US formats, which may cause erroneous errors to be displayed.

TECHNICAL TIP—WINDOWS 7

A bug in the regional date-time settings may mean that Q-SYS date di-  logues don't work correctly.

To fix this, Open *Regional and Language Options*, Under *Format* pick anything else (such as English (United States)), click *Apply*.

Then click *Format* again, pick English (United Kingdom), Click OK.

Perhaps Windows XP is now finally on the way out now that Microsoft have announced the termination date of April 2014. Many of you skipped Vista altogether, and even fewer seemed to use Vista 64 bit but we notice an increasing trend for Windows 7 64 bit to be used for replacing client PCs.

Don't forget that if are planning this you first need to upgrade Q-SYS to the latest database version (Equinox 5) to ensure compatibility. If you already have Equinox 5 installed, we can install a free of charge upgrade to the latest database build if this is necessary.

LARGER PICTURES

If you use the Q-SYS Pack Quality Control module you can now add pictures of multiple visual defects to the system.

A larger space is now devoted to showing these pictures, so QA staff can choose the one that applies more readily.
